“Reaching the Unreached”. What exactly does that mean? PPC has partnered with International Needs to send two indigenous church planters to two of the remaining 7000 unreached people groups in the world. While their day-to-day work will be overseen by International Needs, our role will be to come alongside these two brothers with whatever support is necessary for them to bring the gospel to the Chala and Kotokoli people of Ghana. In addition to prayer and financial support, we will be sending supplies and teams to Ghana at least yearly to minister to both the church planters and the people. We encourage all members to prayerfully consider how they can be a part of this ministry.



The Kotokoli People

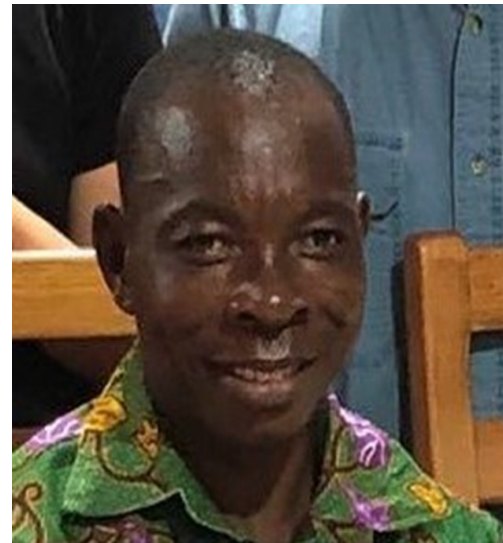
- > No church in native language

- > No indigenous church
- > ~5,000 people
- > Animistic religion
- > Recognize they have been left behind when it comes to faith
- > Hunger for scripture in their own language
