## Food For Thought

God's Accuracy

...have you ever thought about these things?

For example:

- the eggs of the potato bug hatch in 7 days;
  - those of the canary in 14 days;
  - those of the barnyard hen in 21 days;
  - The eggs of ducks and geese hatch in 28 days;
  - those of the mallard in 35 days;
  - The eggs of the parrot and the ostrich hatch in 42 days.
- (Notice, they are all divisible by seven, the number of days in a week!)

God's wisdom is seen in the making of an elephant... The four legs of this great beast all bend forward in the same direction.. No other quadruped is so made. God planned

that this animal would have a huge body, too large to live on two legs... For this reason He gave it four fulcrums so that it can rise from the ground easily.

The horse rises from the ground on its two front legs first.

A cow rises from the ground with its two hind legs first. How wise the Lord is in all His works of creation!

God's wisdom is revealed in His arrangement of sections and segments, as well as in the number of grains.
